-4°C
and below!

When temperatures drop below freezing,
please be cautious of frozen pipes
if you plan to rent out your home
for an extended period.

- ☹☹ Water pipes may freeze, rendering water and toilets unusable.
- ☹☹ Repairs to the water system can take time, disrupting daily life.
- ☹☹ Frozen pipes can burst, flooding the room and causing leaks to the downstairs area.

Three key points to prevent freezing

If you won't be using the water for a long time, drain the water from the pipes.



Please check with the management company for the method of draining water.

Even if you're away for an extended period, do not turn off the electrical breaker.



In winter, wrap insulation materials around water pipes and faucets.



If the water pipes freeze



Wrap the frozen area with a towel and slowly pour lukewarm water over it.

Do not use boiling water under any circumstances!

If the water pipes burst



Close the main water valve to stop the water and contact the management company.
